



Lanesboro Winter Escapades Medallion Hunt Rules

1. The Medallion will be hidden on public land in the city of Lanesboro. It can be found without trespassing, damaging or defacing land or property or otherwise violating any laws. For example, Lanesboro city parks are closed by ordinance from 12 a.m. to 7 a.m. The Medallion is made of materials designed to avoid the advantage of metal-detection equipment and has the 2010 Winter Escapade written on it.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

Anyone is eligible to join the Lanesboro Winter Escapade Medallion hunt except members of the Lanesboro Winter Escapade Committee, members of the Lanesboro Area Chamber of Commerce, Chamber board or office staff, City of Lanesboro employees, participating clue holders or organizations sponsoring or involved with the Medallion Hunt. Also, any members of the immediate households from the above groups or persons.

To be eligible for the prizes of \$1,000.00 dollars from the Lanesboro Winter Escapade Weekends, the finder must have purchased a Lanesboro Winter Escapade button for \$5.00 at Potiche Pottery & Gifts, 113 Parkway Ave. N. If the Lanesboro Winter Escapade medallion is found and no button has been purchased then the prize awarded will be \$250.00 dollars. The winner will receive the prize at 2:00 p.m. Sunday, December 12th. If found before noon on December 12th, 2010. The award ceremony will be at Potiche Pottery and Gifts at 113 Parkway Ave. N. (507) 467-2929. Any tax is the responsibility of the winner.

3. CLUES:

People who stay at participating lodging facilities on Friday and Saturday night December 10 and 11th will have the time advantage of receiving their first clue earlier at 3 pm on December 11th upon check in and will receive the 4th clue at 9 am on December 12th. The general public will receive this same first clue on December 11th at 10 am and the same fourth clue at 10 am on December 12th.
